- * We have a Certified EAGALA practitioner and two INLPTA qualified NLP Master Practitioners. We receive supervision and adhere to the codes of practice of these organisations.
- * We have several first aiders and there is always at least one on site
- * We are all DBS checked
- * We are fully insured
- * We ensure that child protection policies are strictly followed.
- * We have specialisms in Autism and bereavement. We are also happy to support young people who are self harming
- * We also have undertaken Hidden Sentence training to enable us to support the families of prisoners.

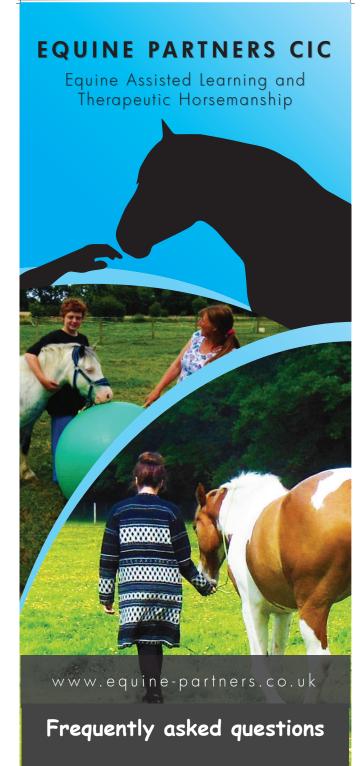

Equine Assisted Learning (EAL)

- * EAL sessions last approximately an hour. (we stop at a good moment close to the hour).
- * Fran, Jo or Clare will help you to enjoy the horses company, play some games and do some thinking
- * EAL is a solutions focused approach so we do not go back into the past. We do look at where the family would like to be and how to get there.
- * There is <u>no</u> riding in these sessions
- * Each EAL session are charged per family. There is no limit on the number of family members that can attend or on their ages.
- * These sessions help the family work together as a team to overcome the difficulties that they are facing and to find ways to make life work as they would like it to
- * If finances are a difficulty do please talk to us. We may be able to help







Who should attend the EAL sessions?

We like to work with the family unit as a whole as this enables all members to understand and make use of the tools we provide and increases the likelihood of the changes being successfully implemented and sustainable away from the horses

We work with all different types of families and across generations.

Therapeutic Horsemanship (TH)

- * These are one to one sessions and are approximately an hour long
- * These sessions are based on a Natural Horsemanship approach in order to develop skills with the horses.



* TH is particularly effective for teaching patience, emotional regulation, perseverance, communication skills and trust and also building confidence and courage.
